


## Establishment of Access

Student login credentials for TCU Online (Brightspace D2L) are provisioned by TCU's Computer Account Management System (CAMS) based on PeopleSoft Campus Solutions and Human Resources data. TCU students and faculty are required to have a TCU account in order to access TCU Online. Students must be admitted to TCU and registered in a course to have access to TCU Online. Faculty must be assigned to a course in class search in order to have access to a semester course.

You must have a TCU ID number to begin building your account. You must have a TCU account in order to be able to register for a class or be listed as a faculty member in a class.

- First time user logs in using their Active Directory identity (LDAP)
- Their account does not exist at the time
  - Sign-on PeopleCode creates PS accounts in Portal and CS/HR
    - Application messaging
    - Component interfaces
  - PS Field sync with ADUC fields
  - Dynamic role assignments
- Code run before login is complete

## Single Sign On

- Okta is the Single Sign On solution for Brightspace D2L and TCU that is integrated with PeopleSoft authentication.
- Authentication Domain must be the same
